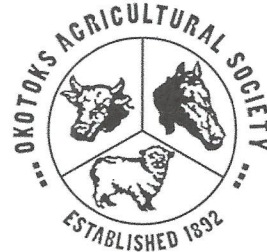

******All Competitors – Please familiarize yourself with the rules as there have been changes since 2016******

Rules & Regulations

1. Show times listed on each entry form
2. Exhibitors will show respect for any and all show officials and competitors. Any unsportsmanlike conduct by any owner/rider/agent will not be tolerated and all fees will be forfeited.
3. **Helmets are required for all competitors 12 years of age and under as the day of the show – No Exceptions**
4. **No Stallions can be exhibited by anyone under 18 years of age**
5. All ages of contestants are based on attained age as of January 1st of the current calendar year. For purpose of these shows a junior shall not have passed their 17th birthday as of January 1st 2022
6. All competitors 18 years of age and under require a parent or guardians signature to compete
7. No mechanical hackamores, Figure 8 nosebands, Tie Downs, Martingales
8. All bits and equipment will follow AQHA rules and guidelines – please familiarize yourself with these rules or consult Show Management prior to your class
9. Notwithstanding the breed requirement/s, the AQHA Rule Book will be the guideline followed in the event of a question or concern regarding bits, equipment, or show management.
10. Junior Horses are considered 5 years and under and can be shown with a snaffle or hackamore or normal bit
11. Horses are classified as over 14.2HH and Ponies are 14.2HH and under
12. A Horse **may not** be shown by more than 1 rider/handler in any class
13. **Please advise Gate Staff of any required tack changes prior to the class**
14. Classes maybe combined or eliminated at show committee's discretion
15. Any act deemed to be rude or unsportsmanlike will not be tolerated. We will not tolerate any abuse to staff and/or volunteers or fellow competitors. Show Management have the right to remove person or persons with no refund
16. No person other than Show Management or Staff may enter the ring without permission from said management
17. Protests shall be made within 2 hours of holding the class to the Show Manager and shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited if the protest is not sustained
18. In the case of any disqualification, the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take that prize and other prizes adjusted accordingly.
19. Any horse that is unsound will be excused
20. Any horse/exhibitor that is unruly will be excused
21. **Helmets** are required for all English Classes. 12 years and under must wear helmets in all Western or English Classes. **Exhibitors may wear a helmet if they so desire in any class**
22. Western hat, boots and a long sleeved shirt must be worn in all Western classes. Helmets will be accepted in western classes as well. Chaps are not mandatory. 12 years and under must wear helmets western or English.
23. The Okotoks and District Horse Show takes no responsibility for injury, loss or damage sustained during the show or on show grounds
24. Entry Fees will only be refunded on receipt of a Veterinary Certificate by the Show Committee within 3 days of the show
25. Please check all your entries and read all class specifications.
26. **Class patterns are included with this program and one copy will be posted – No copies will be at the show – please bring your copies to the show to reduce costs**
27. Any questions on rules will be directed to Show Management, and not directed to the judge directly

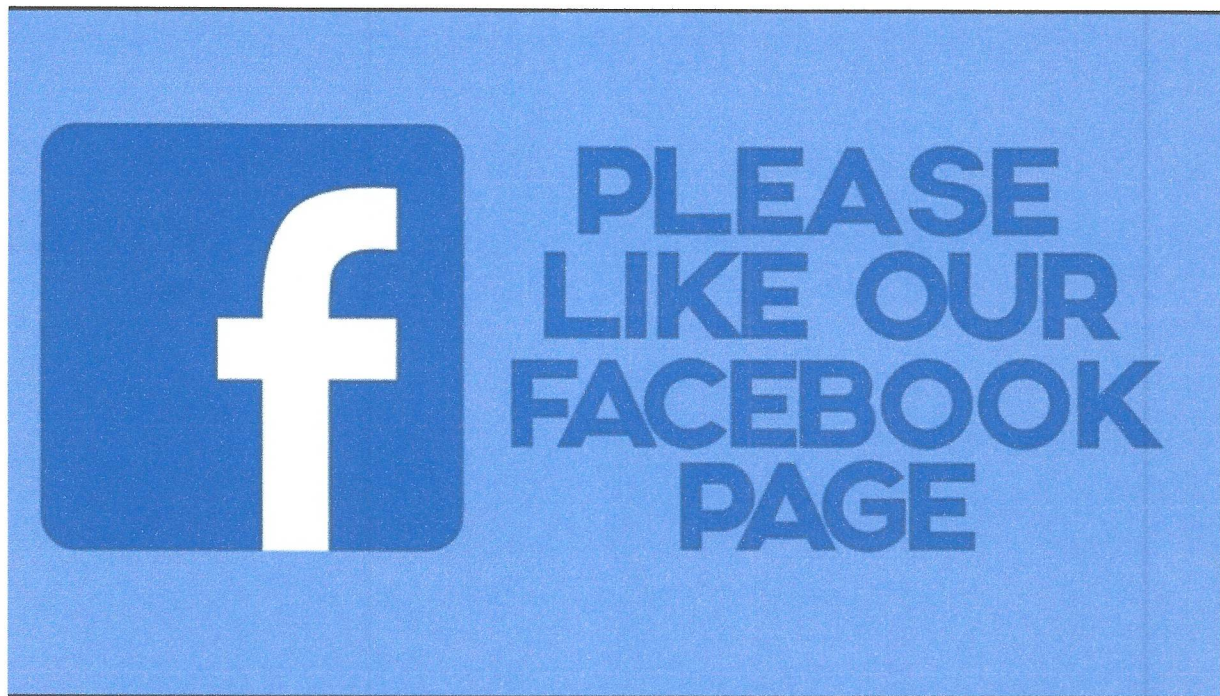

4. Trot away from judge to B
5. Stop at B
6. Follow the instructions of your ring steward

4. Stop at B, perform a 180 degree turn, and wait for instructions from the ring steward

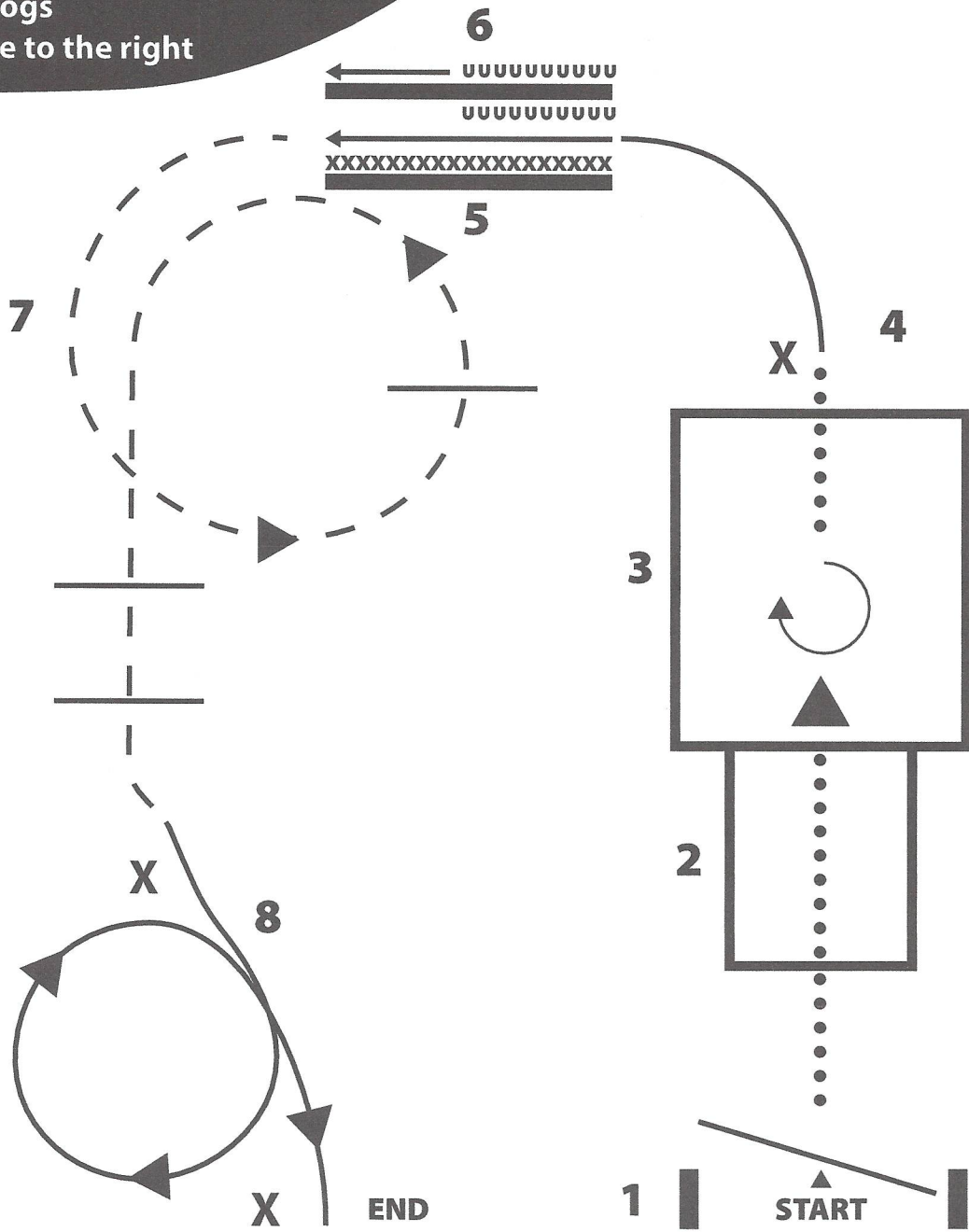

10. Change leads (simple or ???)
11. Collect to the lope
12. Extend trot
13. Stop and back
