Polocrosse is basically lacrosse on horseback, and you only need one horse to play this sport! There are two teams on the field; each team is made up of three players. The field has three zones; the two end zones are for shooting goals and the midzone is where possession of the ball by one team or the other happens. There are multiple levels of play from lead-line, walk/trot, right up to the faster more skilled divisions.
